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## **STEAM for 3rd – 12th Graders (1 ½ hours):**

- Courses are available for Elementary, Middle, and High School students.
- All eligible students in a household may register for programs.

## **Admit One S.A.T. Test Prep for 9th – 12th Graders**

### **(4 hours once per week for 6 weeks):**

- Live, online S.A.T & A.C.T. Test Prep courses.
- Participants will receive a current S.A.T. or A.C.T. eBook to keep!
- Pre and Post-program practice tests are included in the program.

## **Futures for 10th – 12th Graders**

### **(4 hours once per week for 30 weeks-virtual):**

- Professional Workforce and training in subjects such as computer training and business management.
- Courses are online, live.
- Students receive certification and 3 units of pre-college credits for completing course series.
