Use That Planner – A Key to Success

Every Day:

1. Write your homework assignments in your planner daily. Get a parent signature daily. Be accountable for your work.
2. Don't forget to put your name on all papers and turn in homework assignments on time. Remember that a "ZERO" on homework greatly affects your grade.
3. Keep your 3-ring binder organized and bring it to school.
4. Attend class daily and be on time - no tardies.
5. If used, be responsible for Daily Progress Report.
6. Always have a book available to read in advisory or anytime you have free time.
7. Check your homework on your teachers' websites – links are on the school's website (www.sandiegounified.org/challenger). Regularly check your grades on PowerSchool Portal via your student account.
8. Ask your teacher and/or counselor for extra help when needed. We all want you to succeed!

Last, but not least, remember that your main occupation during these teen-age years is to **LEARN** so that you will have the education, attitude and good work habits which will prepare you for a happy and satisfying future.
